Catastrophe of Syria and Turkey Earthquake

Earthquakes, floods, hurricanes, wildfires, and wars have claimed the lives of thousands, leaving millions homeless, without food, water, or medicine. On the sixth of February 2023, we woke up to the disaster of the earthquake, which left thousands dead and hundreds of thousands of homes destroyed. Its passing was not easy; it was filled with numerous trials and tragedies, which we tried our best to respond to promptly. Whether in Syria, Morocco, Libya, or Turkey, we stood ready to help.

Molham Team contributed to the earthquake response in northern Syria and southern Turkey by providing support to the affected individuals on various fronts. We assisted over 150,000 affected individuals, including 50,000 individuals evacuated from the affected areas in southern Turkey. Cash distributions were made to beneficiary families, and shelter centers were established in northern Syria, along with providing essential supplies to displaced families. We also supported rescue teams and hospitals, established medical points, and implemented other response measures required during that time.

Earthquake Response interventions

Distribution of food parcels to rescue teams.

Preparation of shelter sites for more than 1718 families totaling 169,291 individuals. Transportation of the affected and the sick in coordination with hospitals and shelter centers through hotlines.

Medical assistance:

- Including emergency medical care and surgeries
- provision of fuel for medical centers and hospitals, anesthesia, surgical consumables, medications for major surgeries, and mobile clinics.

Humanitarian aid comprises:

- Distribution of emergency kits to 16,835 families.
- Direct cash assistance to 241 families.
- Provision of heating materials for the affected.
- Coffins for the victims.

Campaigns

A lot of events occurred and campaigns were launched in response to the desperate need of displaced families by providing assistance and relief.



Shelter

Shelter program in 2023 managed to turn the tent into a thing of the past for many families in northern Syria, culminating their efforts in the construction of more than 1414 houses, embracing over 378 families of orphans and individuals with special needs. The team executed over 2000 residential houses according to the building code specified for the region, with appropriate standards for displaced persons and consideration for the injured and affected individuals from the earthquake in northern Syria.


This was carried out under major campaigns of the "Until the Last Tent" and "Qadrun Fund" launched by the Molham team for the reconstruction of devastated areas affected by the recent destructive earthquake. This intervention reflected in the main projects and locations of Halal Harim, Armenaz, Qadrun Azaz and Barisha 3.



Education

One of the notable achievements of the Education program this year was the opening of the Gaza – for bright generation School, which included various educational facilities such as a library, laboratory, and space for artistic activities. The school welcomed over 1500 students, including orphans and displaced individuals, and provided employment opportunities for many of teachers and academia staff.

Additionally, the Education program continued to support the education of over 100 university students, ensuring their success and graduation this year. Furthermore, the team provided study opportunities for over 2000 students enrolled in multiple schools managed by the team, such as Molham Orphans School, Fahd Al-Rai School, Gaza School, and Arsal School in Lebanon. Moreover, the team launched campaigns throughout the year to support individual cases of students in their journey of education.



Health


Amidst thousands of calls for help, addressed to the Health program, in addition to hundreds of urgent and routine surgeries, medications, hearing aids, and doses for cancer patients and other types of treatments were provided to over 2687 medical cases during the year 2023 in Syria and Turkey. Medical assistance was provided along with individual medical sponsorships. All of the aforementioned efforts contributed to alleviating the pain of those we could help.

In this year, the Molham Team also inaugurated the Cancer Patients Reception House in Adana, Turkey. This establishment was urgently needed to accommodate cancer patients from northern Syria seeking medical treatment in Turkey, following a significant advocacy campaign to support them, organized as part of the Molham Team's initiatives. The center has a capacity to accommodate 48 patients and is spread across three floors, providing dedicated spaces for men, women, and child-friendly areas



Humanitarian Cases

This program aimed to supports hundreds of the most vulnerable displaced families and individuals by providing Cash assistance, FSL, Cash for rent assistance, Basic necessities, Non-food items, Core relief items



Orphans


The Orphans program has contributed by sponsoring a large number of orphaned children, including 210 children affected by the earthquake in Syria and Turkey out of the total number of sponsored orphans. Additionally, the Orphans Department organized events during Ramadan and holidays, intelligence games competitions, and other activities and outdoor activities for the children.


The program work on daily bases to continues advocating to covering many sponsorships on the waiting list through outreach and advocacy efforts.

Events

As for the Events department, it serves as the team's outlet and beautiful spirit; it is the department that brings happiness to children and adds joy to their innocent faces, becoming a focus of attention and concentration for them. This year, the department organized hundreds of events of various kinds in the camps of northern Syria and refugee countries, including graduation ceremonies, birthday parties, Eid festivals, newborn celebrations, and the distribution of sacrifices and alms contributed by the families of martyrs and deceased individuals.











